CYBERABAD SHE TEAMS REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF May - 2022

SHE Teams Cyberabad is catering to the needs of increasing number of women who are coming forward to register complaints. Total 11 SHE Teams are working in Cyberabad to cater to the needs of more number of women and children. Apart from this, SHE Teams keep a sharp eye on the miscreants causing nuisance in public places. The activities of SHE team for two months March and May-2022.

- Total 170 complaints were received from women victims through different means like Whatsapp, email, Hawkeye, direct walk in etc. All complaints have been acted upon and disposed of on merits.

- 4 child marriages were stopped
- 34 cases have been registered out of which 07 are criminal cases and 27 are petty cases.
- 575 decoy operations were conducted at various places such as bus stops, shopping malls, railway stations, tutorials, colleges, etc. and 78 members were caught red-handed while doing indecent act at public place and 39 petty cases were booked and remaining referred for counseling.
- Regularly conducting night decoy operation at foot court, ladies hostel areas, software companies, metro stations, 100 feet road Madhapur, Kukatpally area bus stops and other hot spots and total 109 members were caught red-handed in night time doing indecent activities and 98 petty cases were booked and remaining referred for counseling.
- 439 awareness programs were conducted and 12,451 people were addressed
- In 52 petitions warning was given on phone to change their attitude
- Counseling sessions were held at Women and Children Safety Wing, Cyberabad which was attended by 210 respondents. All the respondent eve-teasers have attended the counseling session conducted by Cyberabad SHE teams, at the Commissioner office, Gachibowli, along with their Family members.

Some interesting cases.

1. A mobile shop person harassing:-

Received a Whatsapp petition from a woman of Jagadgirigutta stated that petitioner and her husband running a tea stall. She gave her mobile phone to repair in mobile shop near the tea stall, after repair she taken her mobile phone back, since then she is receiving unknown calls from different phone numbers and blackmailing her with morphed photos for money and sexual favours. In this regard she got tensed and approached SHE team. In this regard SHE Team Jagadgirigutta apprehended him with help of petitioner on enquiry the respondent person revealed his name as Bykani Srikanth, age-22 years, Occ: Mobile phone repairer, while repairing her mobile phone he downloaded her photos and personal information. Action was taken against him by booking petty case

2. Trapped a minor girl on the name of love.

Received a Whatsapp petition from Rajendranagar from a person running a jewelry shop about a person by name B. Sagar, age: 28 yrs working as accountant in his shop, petitioner family members were regularly visiting his shop and he moved closely with them as a family member by taking this as advantage he trapped his 16 yrs minor girl on name of love and took her personal photos and used to make video calls through Instagram. After that petitioner came to know about his character given warning and terminated from the job. Then the respondent person started calling her and blackmailing petitioner's daughter that he want to marry otherwise he will blame her character. In this regard her father got tensed and approached SHE team, then SHE team Rajendranagar conducted decoy operation at his house premises and apprehended him and registered a case against him at Rajendranagar PS

3. Stalking by a person

Received a petition from a student stating that she stays in ladies hostel at Madhapur and going for software institute for coaching purpose at Durgamcheruvu walk. Since a couple of days she observed one unknown

person is following her from institute to hostel. One day he came to her and proposed his love due to which she got was afraid and ran away to hostel. In this regard she got tensed and approached SHE Team. In this regard SHE Team Madhapur conducted decoy operation and caught him, while following the petitioner. On enquiry his name is Venkatesh, age: 21 yrs, Occ: Photographer and registered a case against him at Raidurgam PS.

4. Misbehaved by touching a walking woman

Received a petition from a woman of Kukatpally in which she stated that after completion of her dinner she along with her friend were walking in front of their hostel. At that time one Un-known person came from back side of the petitioner on his Honda shine Motor Cycle and intentionally hit her back and fled away. Immediately the complainant followed and identified bike and questioned about the incident. Then the person made a phone call to another person. Another person reached the spot. Then she explained about the incident to second person, but he did not listen about the incident and abused her in filthy language and threatened with dire consequences. Due to this petitioner is feeling very embarrassed and approached to SHE Teams and with effort of SHE Team Kukatpally checked CCTV nearby her hostel, identified rider of bike and apprehended accused persons 1. Virendra, age-36 yrs, Occ- Carpenter, R/o Miyapur 2. Veerababu, age 35 yrs, Occ-Interior designer, R/o Kukatpally and apprehended them and a case was registered against the accused persons.


5. Harassing a minor girl through Instagram App.

Received a petition from a minor girl stating that she is pursuing 8th class, since from last six months she is using Instagram social media app and uploaded her selfie photos, other photos. One of her villager named as Bandela Tharun, age: 19 yrs, Occ: Labour is following her in Instagram and downloaded her photos and uploaded in his Instagram ID as stories by adding text as "I love you, My Happiness, My world, I Love You" petitioner's brother and uncle noticed and asked

him about said uploaded stories then he replied that my wish do what you want, harassing her by following while she is going and returning from school. In this regard she got tensed and approached SHE Team. In this regard SHE Team Pet-Basheerabad conducted decoy operation and apprehended him, while following the petitioner and registered a case against him at Medchal PS and he was remanded for judicial custody.


Most of the women victims have sent messages to Whatsapp and appreciated the good work done by SHE TEAMS. Cyberabad SHE Teams request all the women suffering from teasing, stalking or any other atrocity to approach the SHE teams by sending
